HOW TO DISPOSE OF

Dispose of on the days indicated in the calendar before 6 a.m. or the previous evening. Place your waste inside the container/bag and leave it next to your front door street number on the days specified in the calendar. The waste left out incorrectly or in a wrong collecting day won't be collected and will be labelled with a "non-compliance" sticker.

ORGANIC WASTE: YES

DISPOSE OF IN A CONTAINER, INSIDE A BIODEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE BAG

Fruit, vegetables, eggs, fish and fish residues, shellfish, mussel, clam, etc. shells, meat and small bones, bread, pasta, rice, food leftovers, kitchen waste and spoiled food, coffee grounds, tea and chamomile bags, used paper napkins and tissues, pet droppings and litter (if biodegradable: clay, sawdust, wood-chippings, natural sand or paper based). Small quantities of garden waste and cut flowers, fireplace ash.

ORGANIC WASTE: NO

Diapers, sanitary napkins, toilet paper, rags (even if wet), pizza boxes, packages with food remains (e.g. from butcher and fish shops, rotisseries, etc.), farm animal droppings (e.g. bunnies, hens, etc.). Pet litter composed of synthetic sand.

MIXED WASTE: YES

Packages with food remains (e.g. from butcher and fish shops, rotisseries, etc.). Rubber, cassette tapes, video-cassettes, CDs and DVDs, plastic cutlery, pens, small plastic and bakelite objects, hair and personal hygiene accessories (e.g. toothbrushes, brushes and combs, hair clips and pins, etc.), carbon paper, plastic-coated paper, nylon stockings, jute sacks, rags that can't be used anymore, medical bandages, band-aids and syringes, diapers, sanitary napkins, used toilet paper, cosmetics, bird feathers, pet litter composed of synthetic sand. Ceramic dishes, mugs and cups and potsherds in general, broken mirrors. Vacuum and housekeeping dust, small objects made of varnished wood, lightbulbs, small plastic objects, cigarette stubs, chewin gum, all objects made from different materials that can't be separated.

MIXED WASTE: NOT

All that can be recycled!

Used paper napkins and tissues, pizza boxes, plastic dishes, tetrapak (milk and fruit juice cartons), pasta, rice and cake boxes, paper advertising flyers and brochures, toothpaste, medicines and cosmetics cardboard boxes, plastic packages for potato chips and frozen products, packaging cellophane and styrofoam, styrofoam food trays, plastic fruit crates, aluminium pans and aluminium foil, aluminium cans for hairspray, shaving foam and deodorant. Clothes and textiles in general, rubble, bags of cement, toxic drums, cans containing residues of any kind (e.g. glue, solvent, paint, resin, etc.), agro-industrial residues, agricultural containers containing pesticides, fertilizers, manure. PVC pipes for irrigation, tyres and tubes, car batteries and filters, motor oil and lubricants in general and any car and motorcycle part, fixtures and doors, sanitary facilities, bathtubs, radiators, plumbing, faucets, wirings, boilers, gates, railings, toner.

PLASTIC: YES

Plastic bottles for water, fruit juice, milk; yogurt, cheese creams, dessert, pet food vessels, detergent bottles and hygienic containers. Plastic bags and food containers, cellophane; cakes, potato chips, frozen food, pasta, rice, meat and fish packages. Egg cartons, styrofoam trays and packages, fruit and vegetable nets. Fruit and vegetable crates (1 piece on each collecting day for a single household). Clean jerrycans and tanks, plastic dishes and glasses. Coat hangers, styrofoam trays and small packages.

PLASTIC: NO

Toys, cassette tapes, CDs and videocassettes, plastic cutlery, food containers, hair and personal hygiene accessories (e.g. toothbrushes, brushes and combs, hair clips and pins, trash bins, car parts and accessories, PVC pipes for irrigation, containers and cans containing residues of any kind (e.g. glue, solvent, paint, resin, etc.) and any plexiglass or polyethylene parts, all packages made from different materials that can't be separated.

PAPER/CARTON: YES

Newspapers, magazines, advertising flyers, cardboard boxes, food boxes (e.g. rice, pasta, sugar, etc.), pizza boxes, used photocopy paper, books and notebooks, tetrapak containers (e.g. milk, fruit juice, tomato puree cartons, etc.).

PAPER/CARTON: NO

Nylon, cellophane, wax paper, used toilet paper, sanitary napkins, carbon paper, parchment, dirty paper,

plastic-coated paper and carton, concrete sacks, all packages made from different materials that can't be separated.

GLASS: YES

Bottles, jugs, vases, glasses and glass jars.

ALLUMINIUM: YES

Beverage cans, food trays, tinfoil (e.g. yogurt lids), food cans (tuna, meat, fish, legumes, peeled tomatoes), cake trays, aluminium pans, frozen food and various foodstuffs), tubes (tomato concentrate, mayonnaise, anchovy paste), cosmetic tubes, aluminium caps; cream, deodorant, hairspray, shaving foam cans.

GLASS: NO

Ceramic and porcelain objects, lightbulbs, neon tubes, mirrors, wire glass, opal glass (e.g. perfume bottles), TV or PC monitors, pirex (such as casserole dishes), door and window glasses.

ALUMINIUM: NO

Iron, paint cans.

ATTENTION: non-glass objects have lower melting temperatures and can spoil the final product. Remove caps from bottles and wash glass containers. Do not dispose of glass-aluminium collected in bags.

BULKY ITEMS: YES • YOU CAN DISPOSE OF MAX 5 BULKY ITEMS EACH TIME

Washing machines, dishwashers, refrigerators, televisions, PCs, printers, video recorders, electric ovens, Hi-Fi, bedsprings and mattresses, armchairs and sofas, old furniture, small household appliances (phones, cellualars, blenders, toasters, coffee makers, toys), pallets, wood items in general.

BULKY ITEMS: NO

Rubble, bags of cement, toxic drums, cans containing residues of any kind (e.g. glue, solvent, paint, resin, etc.), agro-industrial residues, agricultural containers containing pesticides, fertilizers, manure. PVC pipes for irrigation, tyres and tubes, car batteries and filters, motor oil and lubricants in general and any car and motorcycle part, fixtures and doors, sanitary facilities, bathtubs, radiators, plumbing, wirings, gates, railings, toner.

GARDEN WASTE

Vegetable residues from garden cleaning, untreated wood and sawdust, leaves and flowers, grass, branches, roots and straw.

It is possible to give small quantities of leaves, grass and cut flowers, with damp, in compostable bags, for each user can collect up to 2 buckets of grass, cut flowers or leaves. Branches, leaves, grass, trunks divided into sections, must be given exclusively to the municipal ecocentre without dirt, stones, vases or flowerpot dish.

Branches must be tied in bundles using exclusively twine or raffia, and must have the following characteristics: length of the branches or sectioned logs, half a meter, weight 20 kilograms (must be able to be raised by a person). The withdrawal of up to 5 packages per user is allowed, for each contribution. The bundles of higher sizes, the non-compliant waste they will not be withdrawn.

EXHAUSTED VEGETABLE AND MINERAL OILS

To be delivered, using any suitable container (bottle, small container) to the municipal ecocenter within the appropriate containers located there.

INERTI

In order to be able to use the service, the interested citizens of Domestic Users in Tari must scrupulously adhere to the following summarized: For inserting recyclable materials into appropriate receptacle of the inert material waste - CER 170107 - at the Ecocentro Comunale, the maximum quantities that can be assigned for each user are equal to 0.2 mc / week (about 4 buckets) for a maximum of 1 mc / year. In order to avoid the rejection of non-compliant waste it is specified that:

- Inert materials (CER170107 mixtures of cement, bricks, tiles and ceramics) are considered only those deriving from small ordinary maintenance works carried out in economics: Eg: rubble, tiles, sanitary, of domestic origin only and not dangerous.

- The waste disposal by or through economic users is prohibited. Waste must be free of impurities such as plastic, paper, cardboard, iron, cables, paint, sheaths, silicones, etc. The provision of Eternit, rock wool, tarred sheath, etc. is not permitted. Aggregate deliveries can only take place at the eco-center during the established times and days (no collection at home).

CAR BATTERIES

Available only at the municipal ecocentre.

USED CLOTHES YES

Inside the waste containers, the following types of

waste can be given: Menswear, womenswear, underwear for men, women, children shoes and paired slippers, blankets, curtains, sheets, towels, bathrobes, bags, tablecloths, napkins, gloves, hair, furs, coats, leather, belts, wallets, work and sports areas.

USED CLOTHES NO

Non-textile materials, unpaired shoes very damaged, blankets used for animals, greasy or dirty clothes with paint or toxic substances, rags, clippings, mattresses, padding and insulation material.

T E/O F PHARMACEUTICAL BATTERIES

TE/O F: Wastes labelled T and/or F (T= toxic; F= flammable)

Toxic/harmful products are all those that must bear the specific symbology so that they can be easily identified and recognised using them for specific needs.

PRIMARY CELLS: Carbon zinc (e.g. remote control batteries), Primary cells manganese alkaline (e.g. for cameras, walkmen, mobile phones), L91/FR-1,5 volt lithium batteries (e.g., laptops, cd players, cameras).

MEDICINES: Separate boxes and instructions that must be delivered in the paper container

HOW TO GIVE T E/O F BATTERIES AND DRUGS?

Deliver hazardous waste (batteries, medicines, labelled goods T and/or F) only in the appropriate containers located in the vicinity of pharmacies and shops. Separate the various types of waste by giving them in the appropriate containers. It is absolutely forbidden to include inside the containers of all other types harvesting.

USED GARMENTS

At the ecocenter is active the service of collection of used clothing such as knitted clothing linen hats blankets curtains in good condition. The material be deposited in plastic bags or envelopes and delivered during the opening hours of the ecocentro.

INERT

Mixtures or dross of cement, bricks, briquettes and ceramics, from small demolitions carried out in economy, from the only domestic utilities. The waste they must be free from impurities such as plastic, paper, cardboard, iron, cables, varnishes, sheaths and silicones, etc. is not

allowed the bestowal of Eternit, rock wool, tarred sheath, etc. The contribution of aggregates may take place exclusively at the ecocentre in the times and on specified days (no withdrawal at home). Ad each user will be allowed to provide 50 kilograms per year.

DIAPERS CLOTH AND SLEEPERS

Diapers, cloths and sleepers belong to the category "undifferentiated dry waste" is collected, with fortnightly frequency. It is planned to harvest twice a week, only for particular categories of users (children, elderly, persons with disabilities or disabilities), which must make a request to the municipal service competent. The days devoted to the collection of this type of refusal are expressly indicated in the calendar.
